

Sacred Harp Singing

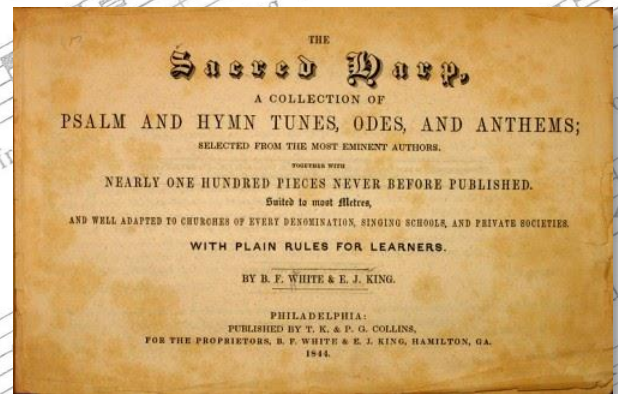
