Sacred Harp singing is an American traditional style of four-part *cappella*, religious, community-based, shape-note singing. The music is powerful, moving and haunting. We sing songs from the *Sacred Harp* with the original sacred harp – our vocal cords.



Everyone is welcome to join us in song, without regard to experience, faith or background. Rudimentary musical knowledge is helpful, but not required. Songbooks are available for use.
